

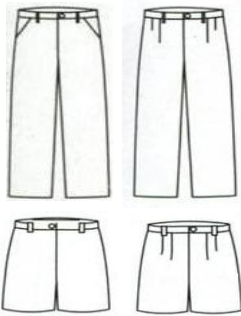


# Pennington School Uniform Policy

All students attending Pennington School are required to wear a full school uniform during the school day and to designated school functions. All students must comply with the Pennington School Uniform Policy as well as the Prince William County School Dress Code. The School Administration/Staff will determine if there is a violation of the uniform policy. A note from the teacher/administration will notify parents if the student is not dressed properly. Students not complying with the Uniform Policy will be required to change into something more appropriate and/or may be sent home to be properly prepared for school (see Level One infractions in student agenda). Students should dress in a modest and professional manner to demonstrate their respect for the school and for themselves. Therefore, all students shall comply with the following:

- Clothing must be appropriately sized for the student.
- No baggy or tight fitting clothing.
- No short shorts, cargos, cropped pants, flared leg, frayed edges or decorative designs.
- No holes/tears or stains in clothing or shoes.
- Pants will be worn at the waistline.
- All shirts **MUST** be tucked in.
- Belts must be worn when belt loops are present.
- All shorts, skirts, skorts and jumpers will be worn at vendor length that is not shorter than five (5) inches above the knee.

**Pennington Casual Days:** Occasionally casual (non-uniform) days are designated at which time all students must adhere to *Prince William County Schools Dress Code and Code of Behavior Policy*. In addition, *Pennington School Uniform Policy* standard must be observed in reference to skirt, skort and shorts length (not shorter than five (5) inches above the knee).

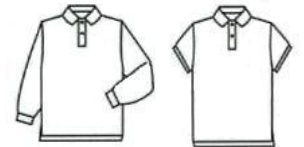


**PANTS & SHORTS** are permitted in three waist styles: flat front, pleated front and elastic waist. All pants are to have straight legs. Both pants and shorts can be cuffed or uncuffed. Not allowed are tight fitting, baggies, short-shorts, cargos, cropped, flare-leg, frayed edges or decorative designs. All Grades: Classic Navy or Khaki.



**TURTLENECKS\*** have a classic collar (no mock turtlenecks). All grades: Classic Navy or White. In addition, Grades 1-5: Evergreen

Long & Short Sleeve **POLO SHIRTS\*** are to have a placket and can be mesh or interlock fabric. Feminine fit is allowed for girls. No picot/ ruffled/ embellished collars. All Grades: Classic Navy or White. In addition, Grades 1-5: Evergreen and Grades 6-8: Maize



**CHINO SKORT** has a back vent for movement, built-in knit shorts and no pockets. It can be worn at or above-knee length. All Grades: Classic Navy or Khaki.



**SKIRTS** are permitted in two styles (shown below) and can be worn at or below knee length. All Grades: Classic Navy, Khaki or Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid.

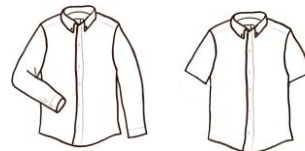


**A-Line** with 2 buttons/ 2 tabs, 1 front pleat.



**Knife-pleated**

**OXFORD & PIN POINT SHIRTS\*** have short sleeves or long sleeves with buttoned cuffs; pointed or buttoned down collars; buttons down front with back yolk and box pleat, and optional breast pocket. All Grades: White. In addition, Grades 6-8: Chamois



**Belts** **MUST** be worn with pants or shorts that have belt loops and must coordinate to primary uniform colors: Navy Blue, Brown, Black, White, Khaki or Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid. Belt buckles must be plain.

**\*All Polo Shirts, Turtlenecks, Oxfords and Pin Point shirts are to be worn tucked in.**



Tailored **JUMPER** has 2 buttons at drop waist and front and back kick-pleats. All Grades: Classic Navy or Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid.



# Pennington School Uniform Policy

**SWEATERS** are permitted in several styles of heavy knit cotton with ribbed neck, cuffs and hem. All Grades: Classic Navy or Evergreen.

**Socks/Tights** must be worn at all times and must be a solid color found in the uniform. Leggings/Legwarmers are not permitted.

**Shoes/Sneakers** must have enclosed heel and toes and must be in good condition. If laces are present they must be tied. For safety reasons, flats only for Elementary. For Middle School, 2" or less heels are permissible. No wheels (Heelies™). Boots are an option and should be worn under the pants (no tucking pants inside of the boot).

**PE Uniforms** (for Grades 6 – 8 only) must be purchased through Pennington School PE department. They consist of navy shorts and light gray t-shirt and are to be worn only on specified PE days. Tennis shoes/Sneakers must be worn on PE days. Girls Grade 1-5 may wear shorts under skirts/jumpers that should be a primary colors in the uniform (navy blue, white, evergreen, or khaki) and must not be longer in length than the skirt or jumper.

**Spirit Wear Sweatpants and Sweatshirts** can be purchased from the school PE department and are available to all grades. Spirit Wear is NOT part of the Pennington uniform but can be worn over middle school PE uniforms in inclement/cold weather.

**Head Coverings** such as hats, scarves, or caps are not allowed, unless related to one's religious belief or practice.

**Ties and Cross Ties** are optional in Navy, Evergreen and Hunter/Classic Navy Plaid.

**Hair Accessories** are optional and are of the students' choosing but should coordinate to the uniform colors (navy blue, white, evergreen, khaki or uniform plaid). Some vendors carry hair bands and scrunchies in the school approved colors and plaid (Lands End, French Toast).

**Hair Color and Style** must uphold the integrity of the traditional school environment. Hair color must be consistent with the natural shades of hair.

**Jewelry** should be minimal/moderate in size and amounts for boys and girls. Earrings are to be worn in ears only.

**Coats and Outerwear** may be style and color of choice except that students are not permitted to wear long trench coats or oversized coats within the school building in accordance with *Prince William County Schools Dress Code and Code of Behavior Policy*.

**Backpacks** are of the student choice, wheeled backpacks are not permitted.
