This week in math we finished up the last part of our unit on Measurement. Next week, students will take their STAR Math and we will review for our math test. Below are the topics we covered if you would like to review with your child. I have also posted an extension module with optional activities in the students Math course.

Math SOL objectives covered in this unit:

- 5.8a Solve practical problems that involve perimeter, area, and volume in standard units of measure (U.S. Customary and metric).
- 5.8b Differentiate among perimeter, area, and volume and identify whether the application of the concept of perimeter, area, or volume is appropriate for a given situation.
- 5.9a Given the equivalent measure of one unit, identify equivalent measurements within the metric system for length, mass, and liquid volume.
- 5.9b Solve practical problems involving length, mass, and liquid volume using metric units.
- 5.11 Solve practical problems related to elapsed time in hours and minutes within a 24-hour period.

## **SOCIAL STUDIES**

On our shortened week we will continue our study of the American Southeast culminating with a map test on Friday. The test will be different than the Northeast test because the students will be able to use their map to answer a series of questions about the region.
