## 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Orchestras:

### Instrument and accessories:

**- Instrument, bow and case (the case must have the student's name on it)**

*Beginning Orchestra: Students will go over instrument selection during the 1<sup>st</sup> week of school. Please hold off until Mrs. Radabaugh gives further instruction.*

*Intermediate 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Orchestra: Students who wish to switch to another instrument must receive approval from Mrs. Radabaugh before moving forward. If you plan on playing the same instrument, make sure you get resized!*

- Shoulder rest- **for violin/viola students only.** (Kun, Everest)
- Rosin (violins/violas/cellos – dark or light rosin; basses – bass rosin like Pop's Rosin)
- Rock stop (cello/bass students only)
